Exam

Registration for the exam takes place online via the PMI website. We explain the registration process and the examination procedure in detail during the seminar. You can either take an online or center-based exam. The PMP® exam consists of **180 questions** and lasts **230 minutes**. The official exam language is English. The exam fee is **not included** in the preparation course and is paid directly to PMI. As an addition to the exam preparation, we recommend the PMI Study Hall™ exam simulator, which will help you practice. The app can be purchased here: PMI Study Hall - PMP Prep App | PMI.

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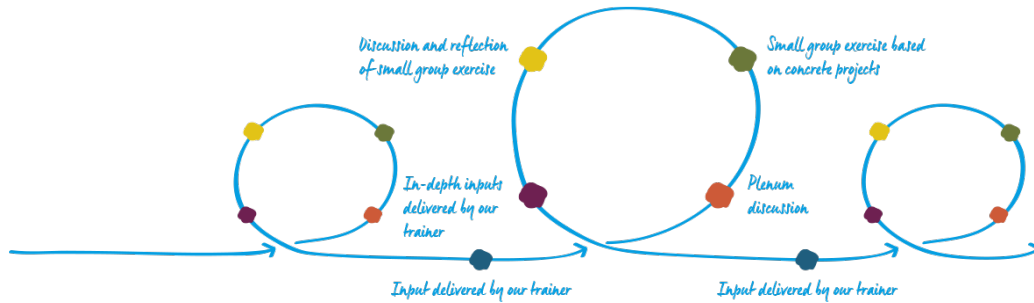
